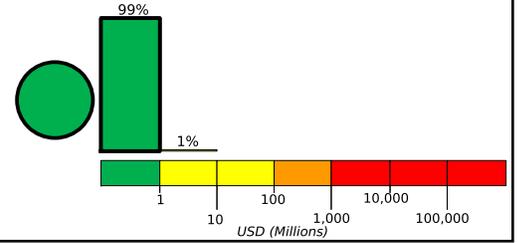
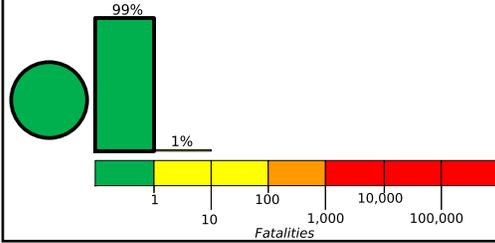

Estimated Economic Losses




