

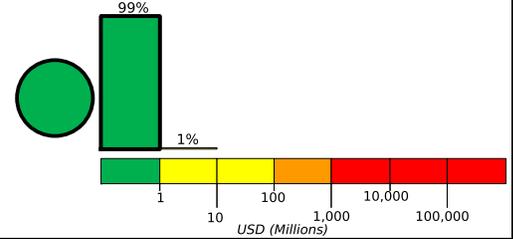

## Estimated Economic Losses





Overall, the population in this region resides in structures that are vulnerable to earthquake shaking, though some resistant structures exist.
